## Europeana Collections 1914-1918: Remembering the First World War

Digitising masterpieces of Europe's cultural heritage

Europeana Collections 1914-1918 has created a substantial digital collection of masterpieces of Europe's cultural heritage : books, newspapers, trench journals, maps, music sheets, photographs, posters, pamphlets, medals and more from national libraries and other partners from eight European countries that found themselves on different sides of the historic conflict. The three-year project makes over 400,000 WWI sources publicly and freely available online via Europeana for the first time.
